Crisis Management Plan

Safeguarding crisis are complex and can be distressing and involves three different types of response.

This document is intended to help you as a senior management team in times of a crisis, particularly any safeguarding crisis.

A senior member of staff will complete the checklist alongside other relevant staff so that the action plan can be decided.

Best practice is that this document should be completed within 2 hours of the incident being reported.

The most effective management of a safeguarding crisis involves co-ordination of all three boxes shown below.

Safeguarding

Actions which need to be taken to keep safe any child or adult potentially at risk.

This response takes preference.

Communication

The communication (as far as it can go without effecting evidence) of what is happening and The actions taken by the organization is taking in response to key members of the organization (staff, parents, media)

Management

The ongoing care for the children for whom the staff member was responsible and the organization response to any staff member accused

Whilst the safeguarding response must always come first attention to other areas must also be taken into consideration which will create a strong and co-ordinated reassurance to the stakeholder.

Safeguarding leads working close together and in co- ordination with senior leadership Senior safeguarding Manager, the Board, Legal team and external teams (LADO, Police)
